## Integrate the Visual Thesaurus into your subscription collection with the “right-click” feature.

### Visual Thesaurus is a foundational reference tool.

Because its search interface is so visual, and because it connects not only words but concepts, users can find information and connections with the Visual Thesaurus that they wouldn't be able to search any other way.

### With the right-click feature, you can set your Visual Thesaurus account to allow users to pop out to other databases by right-clicking on a word.

This allows you to use the concept-to-concept feature of the Visual Thesaurus to search concepts to find specific words and ideas, then search your other databases for those words without having to re-enter the search terms.

### Increase usage of your other subscription databases.

Users who find a concept or word they were looking for will click through to other resources to find out more about that concept or word.

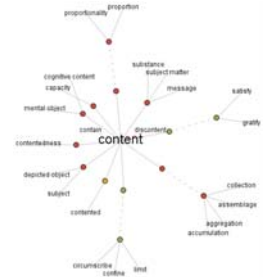
### You choose your own defaults.
