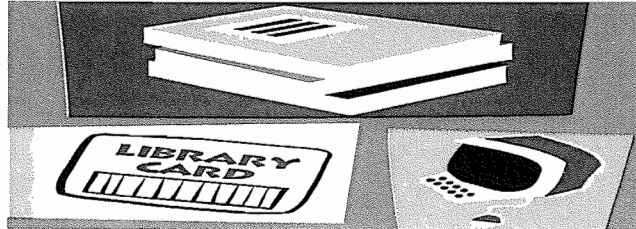

Burlington County Library

Thanks to the efforts of Library Director, Gail Sweet, the Burlington County Library has a new service called "library in a bag." Starting in June 2008, the library will mail requested materials to your home and pay the postage for delivery. The new program is funded by the Burlington County Library System, the South Jersey Regional Library Cooperative and the New Jersey State Library. All Burlington County residents holding a library card in good standing are eligible for the program. To obtain the items by mail, library card holders may use the online catalog or email the library at libinbaq@bcls.lib.nj.us.

If you do not have access to a computer, the card holder may telephone the library at (609) 267-9660 extension 5011. The library cardholder may also request large print of the selected item. All mailed items will be packaged in a turquoise zippered nylon bag or have the turquoise "library in a bag" logo on the package. The items received by mail can be returned at any of the 19 Burlington County Library stations, the bookmobile, library drop off box, or by mailing the items back to the library at the expense of the cardholder. The return label is included in the original package.

The library offers many services and programs for seniors and individuals of all ages. The library web site contains a senior guide page with helpful information and links to senior sites. The programs offered at the main library for August include yoga and relaxation, Tai Chi, rubberstamping, Wii for seniors and health screenings.
