BurlCo Starts 'Library in a Bag' Service

The Burlington County Library has a new service, "Library in a Bag," where card holders may request books, DVDs, CDs and other materials mailed to their home at no charge.

"The Library in a Bag service has been very popular already, particularly by home bound residents, with books being the most frequently requested item," said Freeholder Director Aubrey Fenton, who oversees the library.

Library Director Gail Sweet made a presentation about the program to the Freeholders in July. To obtain the items by mail, card holders may use the online catalog at www.bcls.lib.nj.us or email the library at libinbag@bcls.lib.nj.us. Card holders who do not have access to a computer may phone the library at (609) 267-9660 ext. 5011.

All mailed items are packaged in a turquoise zippered nylon bag or have the turquoise "Library in a Bag" logo on the package. The items received by mail can be returned at any of the Burlington County Library member branches, the bookmobile, library drop off boxes, or by mailing the items back to the library at the expense of the cardholder. The return label is included in the package.
