Definition of "Electronic Resource"

*According to AACR2, 2002 revision, an electronic resource is: "Material (data and/or program (s)) encoded for manipulation by a computerized device. This material may require the use of a peripheral directly connected to a computerized device (e.g., CD-ROM drive) or a connection to a computer network (e.g., the Internet)." **NOTE:** This definition does not include electronic resources that do not require the use of a computer, for example, music compact discs and videodiscs.*
